



Clatskanie PUD Embarks on a New Project - The Clatskanie-Bradbury Interconnection

Clatskanie PUD is working on a new project called the Clatskanie-Bradbury Interconnection. The project involves construction of 7.5 miles of 115 kV transmission line from the Clatskanie Substation to the soon to be built Bradbury Substation at Port Westward. The project will provide the necessary electrical capacity to serve expanding industry at Port Westward and other PUD customers in the Quincy-Mayger areas. The distribution lines along Tichenor and Nehalem Streets will be rebuilt and existing poles will be replaced with higher voltage facilities. The Clatskanie Substation will also be upgraded by increasing the capacity and reliability features.

To you, our customers, the completion of this project will result in increased capacity, greater reliability, and improved appearance.
