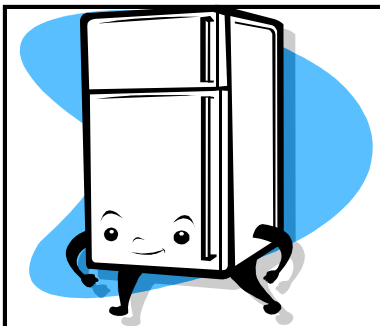

Replacing your old refrigerator or freezer with a new energy star model? The Clatskanie PUD offers a \$50.00 rebate for new energy star refrigerators and freezers. For more information, please contact an energy expert at (503) 728-2163.

The Clatskanie PUD has teamed up with JACO Environmental to provide our customers with a Refrigerator and Freezer Recycling program. The program will offer customers curbside recycling for eligible refrigerators and freezers, a \$30.00 credit on their bill, and a way to save energy and help out the environment.

## Program Requirement

- Your refrigerator or freezer must be empty and working at the time of pick-up
- Refrigerators and freezers must be at least 10 cubic feet in size

## How to Get Started

Call JACO Environmental, Inc at 1-866-444-8907 or visit [www.jacoinc.net](http://www.jacoinc.net) to schedule a pickup. JACO will determine your eligibility over the phone and schedule a pickup date and time. JACO will call you 24-48 hours ahead of the scheduled collection date to confirm the appointment.

## Energy and Environmental Facts

- Research has shown that the majority of spare refrigerators can use 3 to 4 times the energy of newer models
- A 20-year-old refrigerator or freezer consumes on average 1,500 kilowatt-hours annually
- Proper recycling of the foam insulation and refrigerant in the cooling circuit can prevent the release of up to the equivalent of five tons of CO<sub>2</sub> into the atmosphere
- JACO recycles about 95% of the materials used in the manufacturing of each refrigerator or freezer and safely disposes of the toxins and ozone-depleting chlorofluorocarbon gases from foam insulation

## Have Other Appliance That Need Recycled?

The Columbia County Transfer Station offers FREE recycling of clothes washers, clothes dryers, stoves and portable dishwashers. If you have a built in dishwasher they can be hauled in and disposed of as garbage for a fee. The Columbia County Transfer Station is located at 1601 Railroad Ave in St. Helens, OR 97051.
